- o Surface Treatments: Consider galvanizing, zinc-dipping, thermal spraying with plastic powder, or painting steel casings to protect against rust .
- o Indoor vs Outdoor Use: Galvanized steel is suitable mainly for indoor environments, while aluminum-zinc plates or coated metals are better for outdoor exposure .

- o Clean dust and debris using dry cloths; avoid water or harsh chemicals to prevent electrical hazards .
