

Turn off the power to the distribution box

Article Overview

To safely turn off power to a distribution box, first switch off all branch circuit breakers, then the main breaker, and verify power is disconnected.

Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Identify the Panel and Breakers Locate your home's electrical panel, which may be in a basement, garage, or utility closet. Identify the main breaker (usually double-width at the top or bottom) and the individual branch circuit breakers that control specific circuits or rooms . 2. Turn Off Individual Circuits Flip each branch circuit breaker to the "Off" position one by one. This reduces the electrical load on the main breaker and minimizes the risk of arcing when the main switch is turned off . 3. Turn Off the Main Breaker After all branch circuits are off, switch the main breaker firmly to the "Off" position. This shuts down power from the utility line to the entire panel . 4. Verify Power is Off Use a non-contact voltage tester to confirm that electricity is no longer present at outlets, switches, or fixtures where work will be performed. Test the device on a known live outlet first to ensure it is functioning correctly . 5. Safety Precautions

- o Unplug appliances and turn off devices before shutting off power to prevent damage .
 - o Do not touch exposed wires or metal contacts inside the panel.
 - o If your home has a fuse box, remove the appropriate fuses instead of partially unscrewing them .
 - o Consider locking the panel or taping a warning sign to prevent accidental re-energizing .
6. Restoring Power When finished, reverse the shutdown sequence: first turn the main breaker on, then switch on each branch circuit breaker individually to prevent surges . Following these steps ensures a safe and controlled shutdown of your distribution box, whether for maintenance, repairs, or emergency situations.
