

Article Overview

Wall-mounted cable tray supports are typically constructed using cantilever brackets or wall-mounted support brackets, securely fastened to the wall and spaced according to tray load and manufacturer specifications.

Materials and Tools Needed

- o Steel or stainless steel wall brackets (cantilever or L-shaped) suitable for the tray type and load
- o Cable tray (ladder, ventilated trough, or mesh type)
- o Fasteners: anchors, bolts, nuts, and washers appropriate for wall material
- o Level, drill, measuring tape, and wrench

- o Attach the Cable Tray
 - o Place the tray on the brackets and secure it using bolts or tray clips provided by the manufacturer .
 - o For ladder trays, attach the side rails to the bracket; for mesh trays, use the supplied clamp or bolt system .
 - o Use spacers if necessary to prevent tray distortion and maintain proper alignment .
- o Check Alignment and Load
 - o Verify that the tray is level and that all fasteners are tight.
 - o Ensure the tray can support the intended cable weight without sagging.
 - o Maintain proper spacing between brackets according to manufacturer specifications and NEC guidelines .

- o Follow NEC Article 392 for cable tray installation and fill limits .
