o Inspect annually, or more frequently in harsh environments, for signs of moisture, corrosion, or seal

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degradation .

- o If water is found inside, disconnect power immediately, dry the box, replace damaged components, and reapply waterproofing measures .
- o Avoid over-tightening lids on buried boxes; condensation and temperature gradients can still introduce moisture .
