Protection and Standards

Belgian household distribution boxes comply with IEC 60439-3 for low-voltage switchgear and controlgear assemblies and follow the RGIE (Reglement General sur les Installations Electriques) for domestic installations . Typical protection ratings include IP40 for indoor units and IP65 for outdoor or exposed installations, ensuring protection against dust and water ingress . Boxes are also KEMA/DEKRA approved for safety and reliability .

Internal Layout

The internal layout includes:

- o Phase busbars, neutral bars, and earth bars
- o Space for MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, and surge protective devices
- o DIN rail mounting for modular devices
- o Cable entry points with knockouts or gland plates
- o Room for future expansion with spare ways for additional circuits

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Installation Considerations

- o Boxes can be surface-mounted or flush-mounted depending on wall construction and aesthetics.
- o Adequate spacing is required for cable bending radius, heat dissipation, and maintenance access.
- o Compliance with RGIE ensures proper earthing, circuit separation, and overload protection .
