Key Components

Standard distribution boxes typically include:

- o Circuit Breakers (MCBs, RCBOs, RCCBs) for overcurrent and fault protection
- o Busbars for distributing current to multiple circuits
- o Neutral and Earth Bars for safe grounding
- o Isolators for maintenance and circuit isolation
- o Surge Protective Devices (SPDs) for transient voltage protection
- o DIN Rails for mounting modular components

Material and Protection

Enclosures are made from thermoplastics like polycarbonate or ASA, or metal with epoxy or powder coating. Outdoor boxes are rated for IP65 or NEMA 3R to resist water, dust, UV, and impact .
