Definition and Purpose

A cable tray is a rigid structural system designed to support, organize, and protect insulated electrical cables in industrial, commercial, and communication installations . Unlike fully enclosed conduits, cable trays provide an open or partially open pathway that allows for efficient heat dissipation, easy maintenance, and future expansion of cable networks . They are considered part of the electrical infrastructure but are classified primarily as mechanical support systems rather than electrical devices themselves .

Structural Categories

Cable trays are classified based on their design and structural characteristics, which influence load capacity, ventilation, and cable support:

- o Ladder Tray: Features two longitudinal side rails connected by transverse rungs, ideal for heavy-duty power cables and long spans, allowing maximum airflow and heat dissipation .
- o Perforated Tray (Ventilated Trough): Solid bottom with regularly spaced holes, providing moderate airflow and continuous cable support .
- o Solid-Bottom Tray: Fully enclosed, offering maximum protection for sensitive cables like fiber optics, but limited ventilation .
- o Wire Mesh or Basket Tray: Lightweight, open design suitable for numerous small cables, such as network or telephone wiring .
- o Channel Tray: Economical support for branch cable runs, often used for smaller cable drops from a main tray system .

Standards and Classification

Cable trays are governed by standards such as IEC 61537, NEMA VE1/VE2, and NEC Articles 250, 318, 392, and 800, which define their design, installation, and performance requirements . They can be made from metallic materials (steel, aluminum) or non-metallic materials (fiberglass), depending on environmental conditions and load requirements .
