

What does ABS mean in the ABS pigtail channel

ABS Actuator - The work horse of the ABS system, it's the piece that actually releases pressure in the ABS channel to modulate the brakes. ABS Channel - The channel is the hydraulic line (s) from the ABS actuator to the wheel (s). The sensor pickup consists of a metal core surrounded by a coil of windings. When rotated, the tone ring has teeth that change the frequency of the signal sent. ABS operates by preventing the wheels from locking up during braking, thereby maintaining tractive contact with the road surface and allowing the driver to maintain more control over the vehicle.
