Fiber Types

Single-Mode Fiber (SMF)

- o Core diameter: ~9 μm
 - o Jacket color: typically yellow
 - o Supports long-distance communication with low attenuation
 - o Standards: OS1, OS2, and bend-insensitive G.657A1/A2 for tight spaces or FTTH applications
- ### Multimode Fiber (MMF)
- o Core diameters: 50 μm or 62.5 μm
 - o Jacket colors: OM1/OM2 = orange, OM3 = aqua, OM4 = violet, OM5 = lime green
 - o Supports high-bandwidth, short-distance connections, ideal for intra-data center links

Connector Types

- o LC (Lucent Connector): Small form factor, duplex, widely used in modern data centers
- o SC (Subscriber Connector): Common in telecom and enterprise networks
- o FC (Ferrule Connector): Screw-on type, used in high-vibration environments
- o ST (Straight Tip): Bayonet-style, often used in legacy networks
- o MPO/MTP: Multi-fiber connectors for high-density applications
- o E2000: Spring-loaded shutter for dust protection and high-performance networks
- o MU, MT-RJ, DIN: Specialized connectors for certain telecom or industrial setups

Cable Configurations

- o Simplex: Single fiber, one-way transmission
- o Duplex: Two fibers, bidirectional communication
- o Breakout or Fanout: Multi-fiber cables split into individual connectors for high-density racks

Jacket Types

- o PVC: Standard indoor use
- o Plenum (OFNP): Fire-resistant, suitable for air ducts

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- o Riser (OFNR): Vertical shafts between floors
- o LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen): Emits minimal smoke/toxic gas, ideal for high-safety areas

- o Telecommunications networks connecting switches, routers, and transceivers
- o Data centers for intra-rack and inter-rack connections
- o FTTH (Fiber to the Home) deployments
- o CATV and LAN networks

- o Use single-mode fibers for long-distance or backbone links
- o Use multimode fibers for short-distance, high-bandwidth connections
- o Match connector types to your equipment ports (e.g., LC to LC, SC to SC, or mixed LC to SC)
