

What is the fixed spacing of the cable tray

Support spacing for cable trays must align with the manufacturer's instructions, as outlined in NEC 392. Generally, standard trays require supports every 6 to 10 feet, while heavy-duty, long-span trays can handle distances of up to 20 feet between supports. The spacing between trays, whether horizontal or vertical, depends on various factors like cable type, environment, and tray material. Proper installation can significantly reduce electromagnetic interference, prevent fire hazards, and improve overall efficiency. This article provides an in-depth. Although BS 7671 touches on the subject of cable supports, it does not detail specifically what these support distances should be. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is used for instrumentation and control applications that require. IEC 61537 is the internationally recognized benchmark for metal cable tray systems. All cables should therefore be suitably supported. When the cable is installed "clipped direct to a surface", then the clipping distance should be in line with the IET Selection and Erection Guidance

As per the NEC, the maximum allowable rung spacing is 9 inches (230 mm) when cable tray carries sin-gle-conductor cables of 1/0 to 4/0 AWG (American Wire Gauge) (Appendix I).
