

What is the maximum number of wires in a distribution box

- o Each wire entering a splice or connecting to a device counts individually, and mounting straps for devices add to the total count .

- o **Avoid Overcrowding:** Too many wires can cause overheating, short circuits, or difficulty in maintenance .
- o **Proper Wire Management:** Neatly bundle wires, use appropriate connectors, and avoid excessive twisting or bending .
- o **Future Expansion:** Choose a slightly larger box if you anticipate adding circuits later .
- o **Inspection and Maintenance:** Regularly check connections and ensure wires remain secure to prevent hazards .
