- o Velcro straps are preferred over zip ties because they are reusable and less likely to damage cables.

- o D-rings or finger ducts secure cables while maintaining airflow and preventing obstruction . 5. Labeling Systems

- o Label both ends of each cable for quick identification.

- o Color-coded cables help differentiate between power, data, and fiber connections, improving troubleshooting efficiency . 6. Rack Units and Cabinets

- o Properly sized server racks or cabinets support equipment and provide structured pathways for cable routing.

- o Open-frame racks allow easy access, while enclosed cabinets offer protection and airflow management .

- o Plan cable routes to separate power and data lines, reducing interference.

- o Avoid over-bundling to prevent insulation damage and maintain flexibility.

- o Measure cable lengths to minimize slack and loops.

- o Schedule routine inspections to ensure labels are intact, connections are secure, and airflow is unobstructed .
