

What should be used to plug the junction box

Use wire strippers to strip 3/4 inch (19 mm) of casing insulation off the end of every wire going into the junction box. Twist the exposed ends of the same-colored wires together with a pair of pliers. Use a wire nut to connect multiple wires and push them into the box before.
