

What size should the round hole be on the fiber optic cable panel

A common size for intermediate handhole is 17-30-24,12-18-18 inches. In addition, consideration should be given to installing larger-sized handholes if additional cables and/or splice cases may be installed at a future date. The Fiber Optic Association, Inc. Some items used on fiber optic projects should be stock items, like connectors, patch panels or splice closures. Cables, however, may have to be made to order.
