

What types of tees are used in cable trays

o Reducing Tee

- o Allows a branch tray of smaller width to connect to a larger main tray.
- o Useful when the branch carries fewer cables or lighter loads.

o Ventilated or Perforated Tee

- o Designed for perforated or ladder trays to maintain airflow and heat dissipation.
- o Ideal for power cables that generate heat, ensuring proper cooling.

o Wire Mesh Tee

- o Compatible with wire mesh or basket trays.
- o Lightweight and flexible, suitable for low-voltage, data, or telecom cables.
- o Easy to modify on-site for custom routing.

o Solid Bottom Tee

- o Provides full protection for sensitive cables from dust, moisture, or electromagnetic interference.
- o Common in data centers, hospitals, or clean rooms.

Material Considerations

Cable tray tees are manufactured in aluminum, galvanized steel, stainless steel, or FRP (fiber-reinforced

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plastic) depending on environmental conditions, load requirements, and corrosion resistance needs .

Applications

- o Industrial plants: Ladder or perforated tees for heavy power cables.
- o Commercial buildings: Wire mesh or perforated tees for data and control cables.
- o Sensitive environments: Solid bottom tees for protection against contamination or EMI.

Installation Notes

- o Ensure the branch tray aligns properly with the main run to maintain cable bend radius and prevent stress.
- o Use support brackets as needed to handle the combined load of the main and branch trays.
- o Select the appropriate tee type based on cable type, weight, and environmental exposure to optimize safety and performance .
