To connect a wireless router to a fiber optic internet connection, you need an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), a compatible router, and proper cabling to ensure high-speed, reliable Wi-Fi.

Step 1: Gather Necessary Equipment

- o If your router supports Wi-Fi 6 or Wi-Fi 6e, enable these standards for faster speeds and better coverage .

Step 4: Optimize Router Placement and Network

- o Place the router centrally in your home or office to maximize Wi-Fi coverage .
- o Keep the router away from metal objects, thick walls, and other electronics that may interfere with the signal.
- o Update the router firmware and configure network security settings to protect your connection .
- o For larger spaces, consider mesh Wi-Fi systems to extend coverage .

Step 5: Verify Connection

- o Test your internet speed to ensure you are receiving the expected fiber performance.
- o Check that all devices can connect reliably to the Wi-Fi network.
